The BRC Global Standard for Food Safety specifies requirements to be met to enable the production, packaging, storage and distribution of safe food. Certification against the standard provides assurance to clients (retailers and branded manufacturers) that product safety is maintained and reduces the need for retailers and manufacturers to carry out their own audits of their suppliers.

The requirements of the BRC Global Standard for Food Safety Issue 5 have been extensively revised with Issue 6 being published by 31 July 2011 and coming into effect on January 2012. Issue 5 can still be used for audits until January 2012.
